But as I recounted the day in my mind, focusing on all those negative things that either stressed me out of stole my time or just plain frustrated me, I remembered about chapel. It was such a blessing to see so many parents and grandparents able to make it out today! In case you didn't know, Mrs. Pryll put together a team to lead our students in worship.
