Bowling Information Letter

Thank you for your interest and commitment to participating in Bowling Club. The purpose of this club is to provide a safe, fun activity for students in grades 3-8 to learn the sport of bowling, improve their skills, and have fun with other students.

Below is a list of requirements that both the parent and student must read and sign in order for the student to be able to participate in sports.

- 1. There is no room for intimidation or bullying of other students.
- 2. A student's attitude must be in keeping with Christ's directions for pride, sportsmanship and respect for others. Respect will be shown at all times for other participants, club director, bus driver, and any other adults or students involved in the Bowling Club.
- 3. Respect for the other team and other players must be evident even when others act inappropriately. It is imperative that BCA students be a Christian example.
- 4. Students participating must be committed to attend all ten (10) events, which are held on Thursdays from March 3-May 12 (with no Bowling on April 21 due to Easter Break). Bowling Club will leave BCA at approximately 3:10 on the Yorktown Lanes bus and return at approximately 5:15. This is an estimate as students bowl as difference paces and we will have more specific times after a couple weeks. Students not picked up will be checked into After School Care and you will be charged for the time spent.
- 5. Students will be placed in groups of 4, which will be their "team" for the "season."
- 6. The fee for Bowling Club is \$10/week for 9 weeks, which includes transportation to and from Yorktown Lanes, bowling & show rental, and a snack. The fee for the final week is \$12, which will include pizza. The full fee (\$102) may be paid up front, or weekly no later than 9:00AM Thursdays. **Students will not be allowed to participate on any given week if the fee has not been paid!**

There is a maximum of 40 participants, and spots will be reserved on a first come first serve basis. To reserve your child's spot, you must return the Bowling Permission Form/Transportation Form along with the first week's fee (\$10) to Mr. Burnett.
