Mrs. Burnett had a great word for us, too. She reminded us that it is so important to worship God whether we are having a great day or a terrible day. We should worship God whether we feel like it or not because he deserves it!

I want to encourage you to create an atmosphere of worship in your home. It can make a huge difference! After all, it's hard to even have a bad attitude when you are singing about Jesus! Maybe from time to time you even let your kids hear you singing along! They will love to see and hear you, and I'd be willing to bet they will join in, too (as long as they are below about 4th or 5th grade and don't think they are too cool for that!)

Even more than music, let your kids see you reading your Bible or praying! Talk with them about things you are doing to show love to your neighbors or to those less fortunate. Bring them with you when you serve at your church or in the community. Children learn way more by what they do or what they see than by what you tell them. So, don't just tell them how important it is to love God & love others, figure out ways that you can show love to God or show God's love to people as a family!

On a related note, if you tell your kids how important it is to be kind, but you don't show kindness to others, they are more likely to learn that it's okay to be unkind. If you get annoyed at how much screen time they want to have, examine how much time you spend on screens. It is so easy to fall into a "do as I say, not as I do" rut because we often don't pay as close attention to what we are doing as we do to our kids (or other people). But, when we tell our kids how they should live AND model it, they are much more likely to adopt it in their own lives!
