One of my favorite things to do is speak in chapel. Many of you may not realize that I was a children's pastor and teacher prior to becoming principal, so having the opportunity to "preach" to the students is something I still really love to do! Today's chapels, both Elementary and Middle, got a little crazy as we talked about our cups overflowing as in [Psalm 23](#). Hopefully the students will remember that what people say and do flows out of what their heart is filled with ([Luke 6:45](#)), but I'm sure that they will remember the flying Lincoln Logs and Tootsie Pops for a long time! It was probably the loudest chapel we've ever had and was definitely a fun way to demonstrate that biblical principle! As I shared with the students, we can't expect what comes out to be different than what goes in.

My challenge to them is the same that I have for parents today! What is in your heart? Is it good things like love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, & self-control? Or does it tend to be anger, sadness, unforgiveness, fear, or other negative things that overflow from your heart and life onto those around you? When our life gets shaken up, or when we get stressed or tired or uncertain, the "fruit" of our heart reveals itself. For the most part, your child(ren) feel that they are "good trees" bearing "good fruit," but most also admitted that there are times that they struggle and look more like "bad trees" in given moments. What would you say? What is your default reaction when things get tough? If it's not "good," give it to God and allow him to help fill your heart with what he wants to give you. Don't just do that for yourself, but do it for your family, because it affects your kids (and spouse) greatly, and your kids are learning how to handle life by watching and listening to how you do it, whether you like that or not...and whether you realize it or not! Make sure you are setting a good example and setting your child(ren) up for success when they deal with tough things. It's a legacy that will bless your family for generations to come!
