Had we not had a surprise (at least to me) snow day Friday, I was prepared to share a message with our 5th-8th graders in Middle School Chapel called "How Do I Look?" Last week, we talked about how others see us, but this week I wanted to challenge everyone to look at themselves through God's eyes. We can act a certain way in order to impress people. We can hide our true feelings and thoughts, and even actions many times. But, God sees it all. He sees us when we are good, and when we are not. He sees us when we act as a "representative of the Lord Jesus" ([Col. 3:17](#)) and when we act like "whitewashed tombs" ([Matt. 23:27-28](#)). There are moments that we make God smile, and moments when I'm sure he doesn't. While no one is perfect and we all fall short, we are thankfully covered by his grace ([Rom. 3:22-24](#)). However, we need to know what it means to be a "Christian" or to be "saved." We need to define those words and not just take them for granted, because if we don't truly understand them, we won't take Jesus's words in [Matthew 16:24](#) seriously. We will be a "Christian" when it suits us, or when it benefits us, or when others expect us to act like one, but that is not enough. God wants you to fully understand that label, and to step up and live it out. People in the world don't need part-time Christians...they have a word for them: "hypocrites." This world needs men and women devoted to Christ, the Gospel, and committed to living as a disciple of Jesus Christ 24/7/365. It doesn't mean we are perfect, or even that we pretend to be, but it means that we do our best, in the big things and the small, and that when we miss the mark we own it. We ask forgiveness and do better the next time! It is a serious calling, for parents, teachers, students, and all Christians. So, let me ask you this question today: How do you look to God?

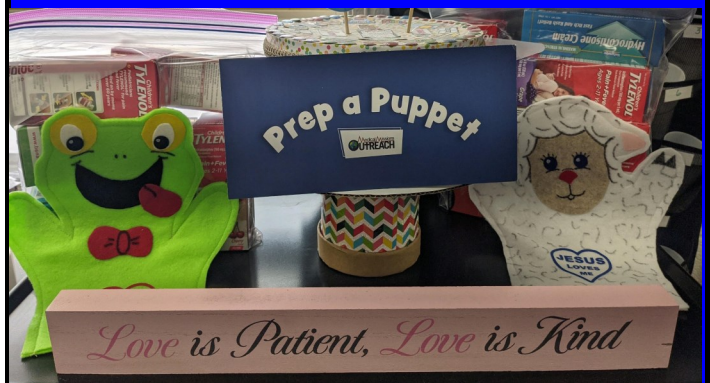
